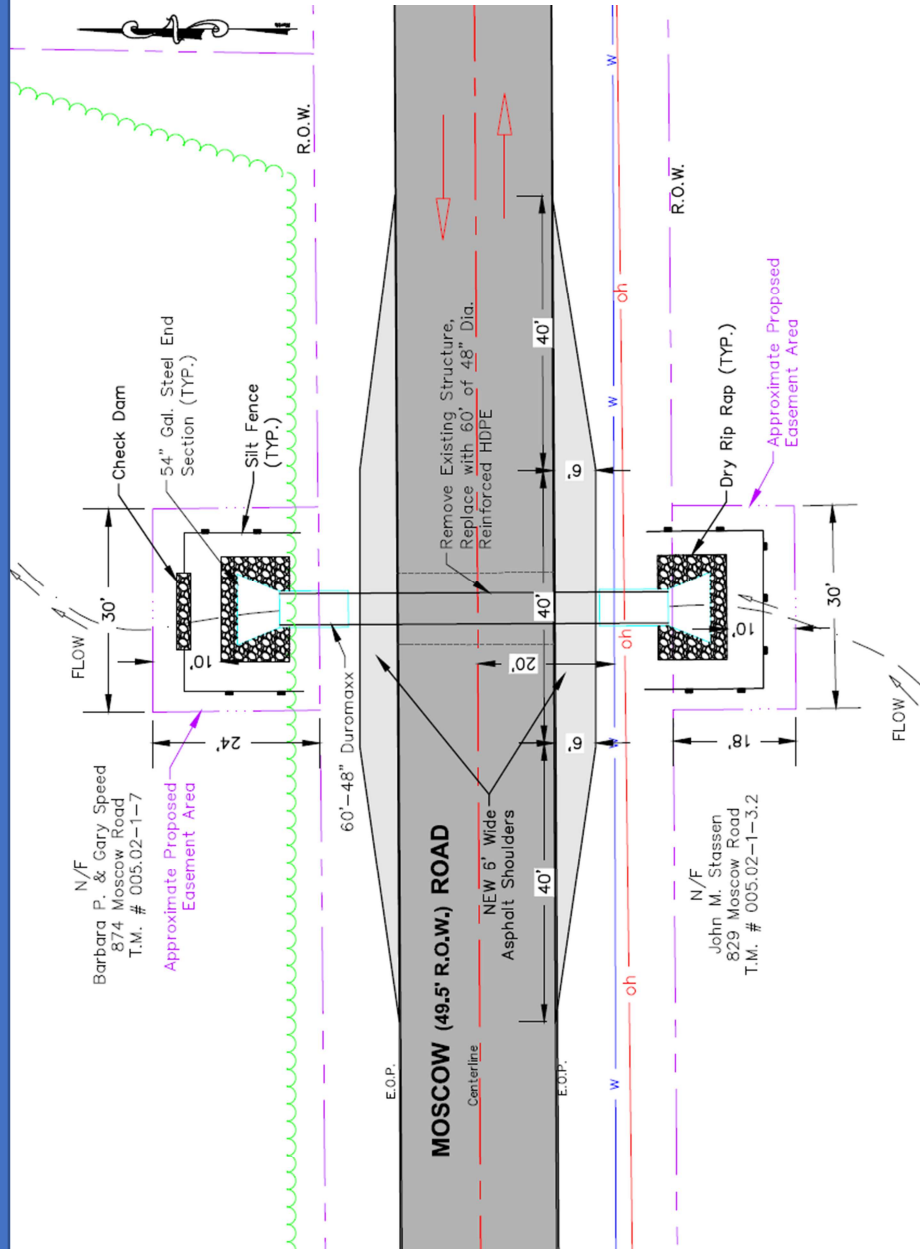
**TUESDAY, JANUARY 28, 2020**

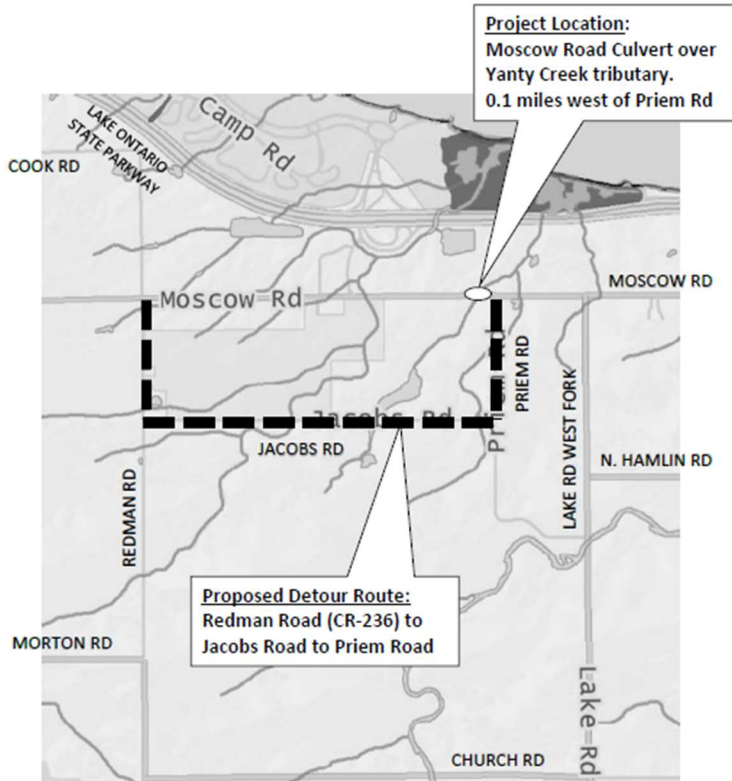

MOSCOW ROAD CULVERT REPLACEMENT PROJECT  
S.I.N. 06-211-293  
0.1 MILES WEST OF PRIEM ROAD

**Project Location:** Moscow Road (County Road 211) over Yanty Creek Tributary is 0.1 miles west of Priem Road.

**Project Objective:** The Monroe County Department of Transportation would like to replace an existing 54"x30" corrugated metal arch culvert on Moscow Road with a new 48" diameter steel reinforced polyethylene pipe. The new culvert was selected to provide structural, hydraulic, and geometric improvements to meet current codes and standards, while being the most maintenance-free and cost-effective solution with the greatest duration and longevity.

**Pedestrian Access:** Pedestrians will not be allowed in the area during construction.

**Permitting Required:** SEQRA Type II Action, Joint NYSDEC/USACOE Permit Nationwide Permit #3 – Maintenance 401 Water Quality Certification

**Traffic Maintenance:** A detour will be used to direct traffic down Priem Road, Jacobs Road, and Redman Road to travel around the construction site.

**Anticipated Schedule:** Begin Construction: Summer, 2020  
End Construction: Fall, 2020

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
