This informational newsletter will provide periodic updates (as needed) on the status of the North Road Rehabilitation Project and communicate upcoming construction activities to local residents.

CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

DRAINAGE AND CURB INSTALLATION

The drainage and shoulder work has been substantially completed within the section of the road located between NY Rt. 386 and the Village line. In the next two months, the contractor will be working in the section of the project between the Village line and NY Rt. 383.

This work will involve:

- Removal of the concrete gutter
- Installation of new catch basins and drainage pipes
- Installation of granite curbing
- Construction of the full depth shoulder area
- Restoration of yard areas behind the new curbing (weather dependent)

The contractor will be installing curbing in sections of the project of a length that can be completed in one day. During the time the curbing is being placed in a section, driveway access will be restricted on that day. The contractor will be notifying residents about this work the day before the work is planned via a letter that will be placed at your door.

Lawn Restoration Tips

- A light watering of the newly seeded area 3-4 days a week will encourage growth.
- When the new grass reaches a height of 3", it should be mowed similar to the remainder of your lawn.
- Regardless if some weeds begin to grow, keep mowing regularly. Continued mowing will allow the new grass to crowd out the weeds. Allowing the weeds to grow taller and not mowing will have the opposite effect.

We appreciate your continued patience during the work activities for the protection of our workers. The project remains on schedule to be completed this Fall.
