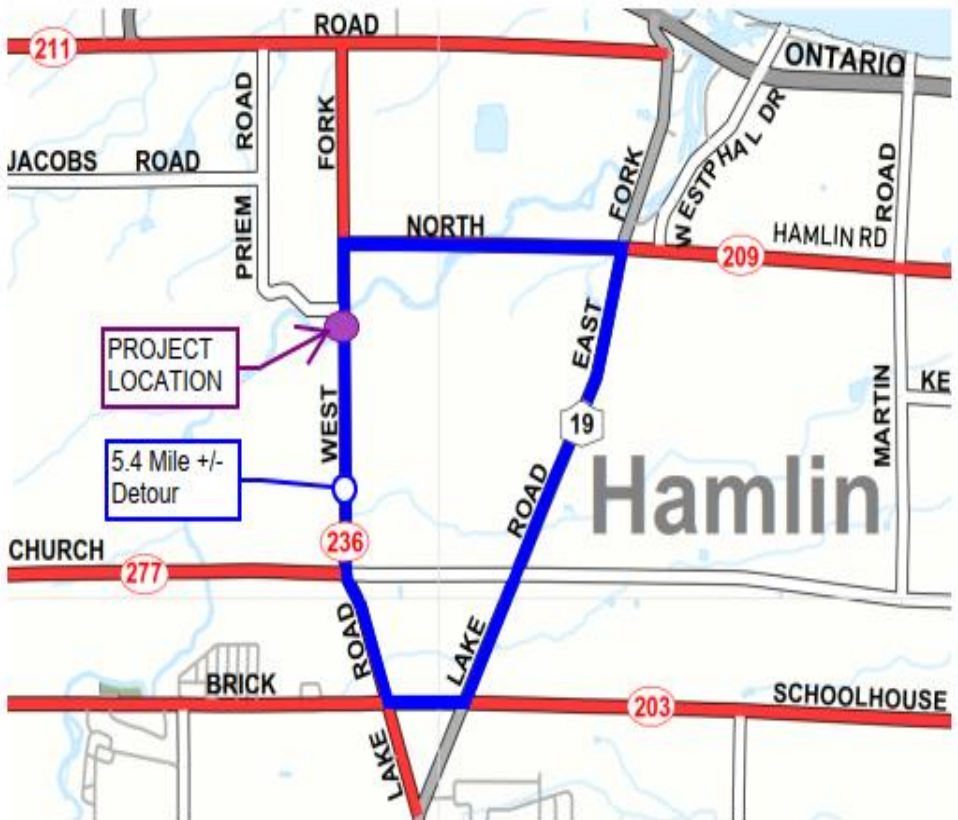

Project Location: Lake Road West Fork over Sandy Creek is located 0.3 mile south of North Hamlin Road (CR 209), at the intersection of Priem Road.

Project Objective: Provide a cost effective, durable and maintenance free solution to the structural, hydraulic, and geometric deficiencies of the existing crossing, meeting the latest design standards.

Proposed Alternative: Bridge Rehabilitation

Pedestrian Access: Pedestrians will not be allowed in the area during construction.

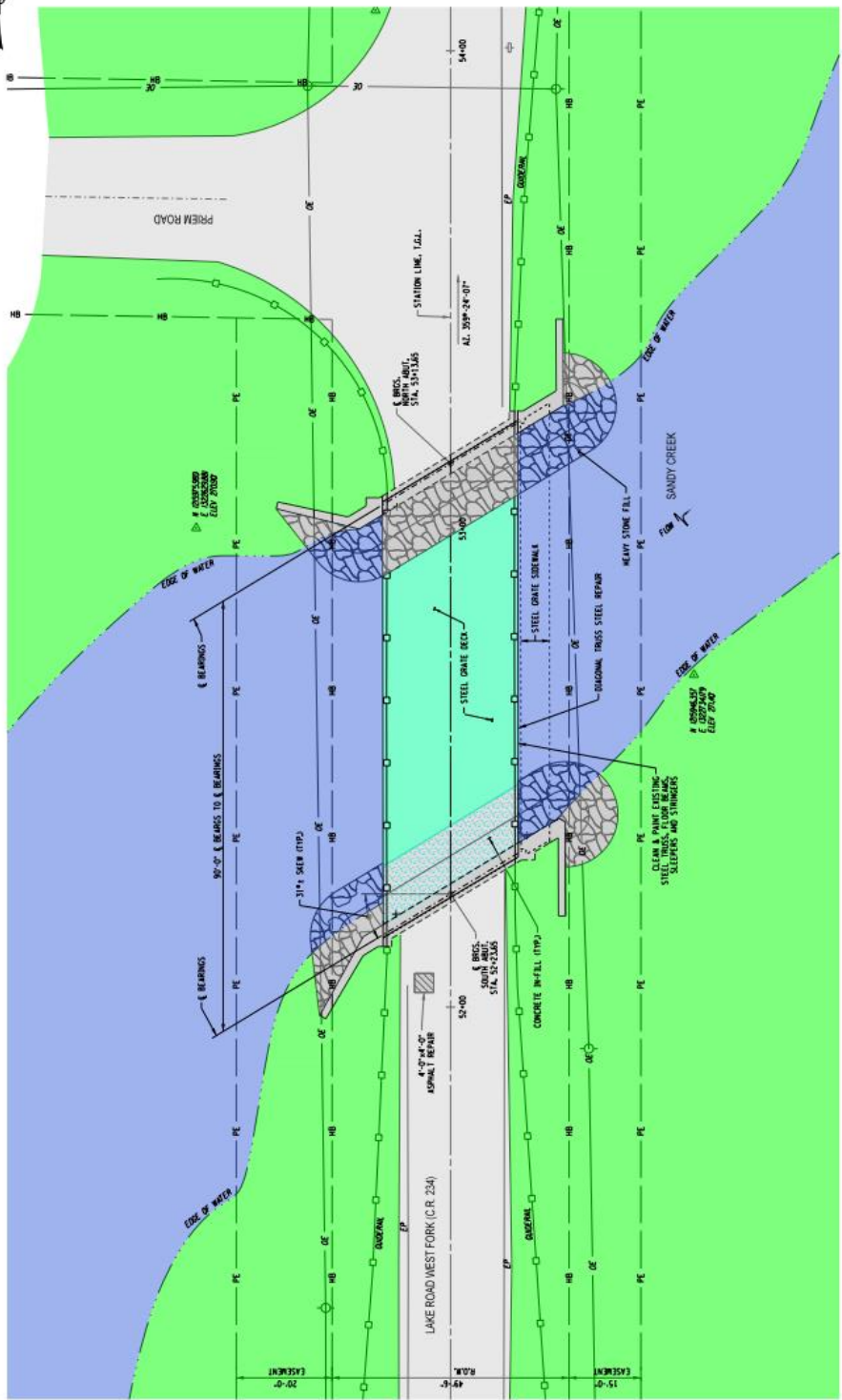
Environmental Classification and Permits: SEQRA Type II

Maintenance of Traffic: The work will be completed using an off-site detour to maintain traffic during construction. The detour will use Brick Schoolhouse Road (CR 203), Lake Road East Fork (NY Route 19) and North Hamlin Road (CR 209).

Anticipated Schedule: Begin Construction - Summer 2021
End Construction - Fall 2021
