# TRANSPORTATION NEWS

*This informational newsletter will provide periodic updates (as needed) on the status of the Bay Road Improvement Project and communicate upcoming construction activities to local residents.*

## CURRENT PROJECT STATUS

### ROAD WORK STARTING ON BAY ROAD (NYS ROUTE 104 TO LAKE ROAD)

Beginning on, or around, **Monday June 15**, Monroe County DOT’s contractor, Keeler Construction Co., Inc., will begin work on the “**Bay Road Improvements Project**”. The limits of this project are from the NYS Route 104 to Lake Road.

The project work will include:

- Spot replacement of damaged curb.
- Adjustments to existing drainage grates and manhole covers to meet proper grade.
- Milling and paving of the existing pavement surface.
- Installation of new signs and pavement markings to create a revised lane configuration.
  - The existing 4-lane configuration will be re-striped as a 3-lane configuration with a single lane of traffic in each direction, a center turning lane, and wider shoulders.
    - Note that the limits of the 3-lane configuration have been recently revised and will now be from immediately north of NYS Route 104 to Lake Road.
    - This revision was made in coordination with the Town of Webster in order to better realize the safety benefits which a lane reconfiguration like this is proven to have, which includes:
      - Reduction in accidents and vehicle speeds
      - Better accommodations for vehicles making left turns
      - Wider shoulders which will better accommodate bicycle and pedestrian traffic, as well as providing space for mail/package delivery, landscape or other residential service trucks, and garbage trucks.

Typical work will require shoulder closures, single lane closures, lane shifts, and flagging operations. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the project is expected to be completed in early August. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause, and ask for your patience during the project.
