**RE: Long Pond Road and Mitchell Road Pavement Resurfacing
Monroe County Highway Preventive Maintenance Project #9**

Dear Neighbor:

Beginning on, or around, Monday, April 18th, Keeler Construction, a contractor for the Monroe County DOT, is scheduled to begin work on **Long Pond Road (including Mitchell Road) between Ridgeway Avenue and Janes Road**. Work will include: repair and cleaning of portions of the storm sewer system, upgrade of sidewalk ramps, repairs to existing curbing, milling and resurfacing of the top layer of asphalt, and installation of new pavement markings.

During construction, two-way traffic will be maintained with daily lane closures as needed. Flaggers will be utilized, at times, to guide traffic around the work areas. Continuous access to driveways and side streets will be maintained, except when work is occurring directly in front of these access points. In these instances, there may be a brief delay until flaggers indicate that it is safe to cross the work zone.

The work is expected to be completed by mid-to-late October. We apologize for any inconvenience this work may cause, and ask for your patience during the project.
