Hospitalized

40 individuals are hospitalized, 10 people are in ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 4404 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 4725 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1853 tests per day (PCR). There have been 144,049 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
