Message from Monroe County Public Health Commissioner Michael Mendoza: We are reporting two new COVID-19 related deaths since this morning. I share in the sorrow of their family, friends and our entire community and thank the healthcare providers who remain committed to their jobs in this trying time.

Beginning tomorrow, the Monroe County Department of Public Health will begin a once daily COVID-19 Update. It will be released at approximately 4 p.m. each day. There will not be a 10 a.m. Update anymore.

Confirmed Cases

There are 257 confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Monroe County.

There are 11 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the 10 a.m. update. These new individuals include:

- 257 positive results

Hospitalized patients

Of the 257 confirmed cases, 42 people are hospitalized, 25 of the 42 patients are in ICU.

Of the 257 confirmed cases, 76 people resolved and have been released from isolation.
