Deaths

There were 4 new deaths since Friday, April 17, bringing the total to 68.

Hospitalized

Of the 997 confirmed cases, 93 people are hospitalized. 32 of the 93 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 426 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 575 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
