There are 19 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the 4 p.m. update on Saturday, April 18.

Deaths

There were 3 new deaths since Saturday, April 18, bringing the total to 71.

Hospitalized

Of the 1016 confirmed cases, 97 people are hospitalized. 30 of the 97 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 442 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 589 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
