Message from Public Health Commissioner Dr. Michael Mendoza: Monroe County has seen a rise in positive COVID-19 cases in recent days due, in part, to an increase in testing capacity, broadened state guidelines of who can be tested and increased efforts to test known contacts of previously positive cases. We have also taken proactive measures to increase testing in at-risk settings in an effort to identify cases in the early stages of infection and minimize spread of COVID-19.

New Cases

There are 96 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the 4 p.m. update on Monday, May 18.

Hospitalized

Of the 2363 confirmed cases, 146 people are hospitalized. 17 of the 146 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 1153 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 1405 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

We are providing additional information on daily and total testing capacity for Monroe County.

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1010 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 29970 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
