There are 80 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Wednesday, May 20.

Deaths

There were 3 new deaths since Wednesday, May 20, bringing the total to 185.

Hospitalized

Of the 2508 confirmed cases, 157 people are hospitalized. 16 of the 157 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.



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Recovered from Isolation

There have been 1239 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 1495 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1251 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 31310 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
