Hospitalized

Of the 2704 confirmed cases, 176 people are hospitalized. 17 of the 176 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 1423 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 1689 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

We are providing additional information on daily and total testing capacity for Monroe County.

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 635 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 35985 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
