There are 39 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Tuesday, May 26.

Hospitalized

Of the 2742 confirmed cases, 190 people are hospitalized. 18 of the 190 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

There have been 1472 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 1741 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

We are providing additional information on daily and total testing capacity for Monroe County.

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1103 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 36586 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
