Monroe County COVID-19 Dashboard

New Cases

There are 11 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Sunday, May 31.

These new individuals include:

- 2 Females in their 20s
- 3 Females in their 40s
- 2 Males in their 50s
- 2 Females in their 60s
- 1 Male in his 70s
- 1 Male in his 80s

Deaths

There were 5 new deaths since Sunday, May 31, bringing the total to 224.

Hospitalized

Of the 2888 confirmed cases, 188 people are hospitalized. 20 of the 188 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 1746 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2032 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 832 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 42825 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
