Deaths

There were 3 new deaths since Monday, June 1, bringing the total to 227.

Hospitalized

Of the 2931 confirmed cases, 187 people are hospitalized. 20 of the 187 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 1811 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2101 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

We are providing additional information on daily and total testing capacity for Monroe County.

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1734 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 45273 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
