New Cases

There are 18 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Sunday, June 7.

- 2 Females in their 40s
- 2 Males in their 50s

- 1 Male in his 90s

Deaths

There were 3 new deaths since Sunday, June 7, bringing the total to 239.

Hospitalized

Of the 3110 confirmed cases, 169 people are hospitalized. 17 of the 169 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2013 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2319 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
