New Cases

There are 22* new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Wednesday, June 10.

Deaths

There were 0 new deaths since Wednesday, June 10. The total remains at 247.

Hospitalized

Of the 3176 confirmed cases, 151 people are hospitalized. 16 of the 151 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.



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Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2081 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2391 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1414 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 55697 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
