There are 27 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Saturday, June 13.

Deaths

There were 2 new deaths since Saturday, June 13, bringing the total to 250.

Hospitalized

Of the 3238 confirmed cases, 144 people are hospitalized. 17 of the 144 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2141 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2454 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1144 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 59130 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
