New Cases

There are 16 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Monday, June 15.

These new individuals include:

- 1 Female between 10 and 19 years of age
- 1 Male between 10 and 19 years of age
- 3 Females in their 20s
- 3 Females in their 30s
- 3 Females in their 40s
- 1 Female in her 60s
- 2 Males in their 70s
- 1 Female in her 80s
- 1 Male in his 80s

Deaths

There were 2 new deaths since Monday, June 15, bringing the total to 252.

Hospitalized

Of the 3262 confirmed cases, 131 people are hospitalized. 16 of the 131 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2208 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2525 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1046 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 60467 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
