### **New Cases**

There are 21 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Wednesday, June 17.

These new individuals include:

- 6 Females in their 20s
- 5 Males in their 20s
- 2 Females in their 30s
- 5 Males in their 30s
- 1 Female in her 40s
- 1 Female in her 60s
- 1 Female in her 70s

### **Deaths**

There was 1 new death since Wednesday, June 17. The total remains at 255.

### **Hospitalized**

Of the 3302 confirmed cases, 117 people are hospitalized. 14 of the 117 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

### **Recovered from Isolation**

There have been 2597 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2916 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

### **Testing**

The 3-day average of daily total PCR test taken in Monroe County is currently at 824 tests per day.

There have been 61861 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
