Deaths

There were 2 new deaths since Friday, June 19, for a total of 259 to date.

Hospitalized

Of the 3338 confirmed cases, 108 people are hospitalized. 11 of the 108 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2644 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2964 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 660 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 63312 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
