New Cases

There are 18 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Saturday, June 20. There have been 3356 positive COVID-19 case in Monroe County to date.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2673 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 2993 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 834 tests per day (PCR and Antibody testing).

There have been 64363 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
