New Cases

There are 30 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Monday, June 22.

These new individuals include:

- 1 Male 0-10
- 2 Females, 2 Males 10-20
- 7 Females, 4 Males 20-30
- 1 Female, 1 Male 30-40
- 1 Female, 40-50
- 2 Females, 3 Males 50-60
- 2 Females, 1 Male 60-70
- 1 Female, 2 Males 70-80

Deaths

There were 3 new deaths. The total is 264 to date.

Hospitalized

Of the 3392 confirmed cases, 88 people are hospitalized. 11 of the patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2699 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3019 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
