### New Cases

There are 38 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the update on Wednesday, June 24.

These new individuals include:

- 4 Females, 1 Males 10-20
- 6 Females, 4 Males 20-30
- 7 Females, 1 Males 30-40
- 3 Females, 1 Males 40-50
- 3 Females, 2 Males
- 2 Females 50-60
- 2 Males 70-80
- 2 Females 80-90

### Deaths

There was 1 new death. The total is 266 to date.

### Hospitalized

Of the 3463 confirmed cases, 83 people are hospitalized. 10 of the patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

### Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2746 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3066 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

### Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 909 tests per day (PCR).

There have been 67914 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
