### **New Cases**

There are 23 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the last update.

These new individuals include:

- 6 Females 5 Males 20-30
- 2 Females 1 Male 30-40
- 2 Males 40-50
- 1 Female 1 Male 50-60
- 2 Males 60-70
- 1 Male 70-80
- 0 80-90
- 1 Female 1 Male 90-100

### **Deaths**

There were 0 new deaths. The total is 269 to date.

### **Hospitalized**

Of the 3517 confirmed cases, 76 people are hospitalized. 10 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

### **Recovered from Isolation**

There have been 2794 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3114 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

### **Testing**

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 833 tests per day (PCR).
