New Cases

There are 33 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the last update.

These new individuals include:

- 1 Female 0-10
- 3 Females 10-20
- 8 Females 4 Males 20-30
- 4 Females 4 Males 30-40
- 2 Females 2 Males 40-50
- 2 Females 1 Male 50-60
- 0 60-70
- 1 Female 70-80
- 1 Male 90-100

Deaths

There was 1 new death. The total is 271 to date.

Hospitalized

Of the 3602 confirmed cases, 76 people are hospitalized. 9 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 2845 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3165 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
