### **New Cases**

There are 25 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the last update.

These new individuals include:

- 1 Male 0-10
- 1 Female 10-20
- 4 Females 3 Males 20-30
- 4 Females 30-40
- 3 Females 40-50
- 4 Females 1 Male 50-60
- 1 Female 60-70
- 1 Female 1 Male 70-80
- 1 Male 90-100

### **Deaths**

There were 3 new deaths. The total is 276 to date.

### **Hospitalized**

Of the 3814 confirmed cases, 69 people are hospitalized, 6 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

### **Recovered from Isolation**

There have been 3111 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3431 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
