Monroe County COVID-19 Dashboard

Monroe County updates the dashboard daily. Please remember that the numbers reflected on the dashboard are not official until the date and timestamp have been updated to today's date.

New Cases

There are 55 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the last update.

These new individuals include:

- 2 Females 0-10
- 3 Females 10-20
- 10 Females 5 Males 20-30
- 3 Females 9 Males 30-40
- 2 Females 1 Male 40-50
- 7 Females 6 Males 50-60
- 3 Females 3 Males 60-70
- 1 Female 70-80

Deaths

There were 0 new deaths. The total is 277 to date.

Hospitalized

Of the 3933 confirmed cases, 64 people are hospitalized, 4 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 3222 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3543 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1252 tests per day (PCR). There have been 84209 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
