Monroe County COVID-19 Dashboard

Monroe County updates the dashboard daily. Please remember that the numbers reflected on the dashboard are not official until the date and timestamp have been updated to today's date.

New Cases

There are 31 new confirmed cases of COVID-19 since the last update.

These new individuals include:

- 1 Male 0-9
- 1 Female 10-19
- 5 Females 8 Males 20-29
- 4 Females 1 Male 30-39
- 3 Females 1 Male 40-49
- 2 Females 2 Males 50-59
- 1 Female 60-69
- 1 Female 1 Male 70-79

Deaths

There were 0 new deaths. The total is 277 to date.

Hospitalized

Of the 3964 confirmed cases, 68 people are hospitalized, 4 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 3266 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3587 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1224 tests per day (PCR). There have been 85649 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
