## **Deaths**

There were 0 new deaths. The total is 279 to date.

## **Hospitalized**

Of the 4204 confirmed cases, 58 people are hospitalized, 8 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

## **Recovered from Isolation**

There have been 3509 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3830 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.
