Deaths

There was 1 new death. The total is 280 to date.

Hospitalized

Of the 4246 confirmed cases, 57 people are hospitalized, 6 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 3581 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3902 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1276 tests per day (PCR). There have been 98479 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
