## **Deaths**

There were 0 new deaths. The total is 280 to date.

## **Hospitalized**

Of the 4284 confirmed cases, 55 people are hospitalized, 7 patients are in the ICU on a ventilator.

## **Recovered from Isolation**

There have been 3622 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 3943 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

## **Testing**

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1276 tests per day (PCR). There have been 99436 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
