## **Recovered from Isolation**

There have been 3846 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 4167 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1162 tests per day (PCR). There have been 110,968 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
