There have been 3959 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 4280 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

## **Testing**

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1654 tests per day (PCR). There have been 118,214 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
