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Recovered from Isolation

There have been 5062 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 5383 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1322 tests per day (PCR). There have been 185,444 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.
