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Deaths

There were 0 new deaths. The total is 307 to date.

Hospitalized

136 people in the Finger Lakes Region are hospitalized, 31 of them are in ICU

Recovered from Isolation

There have been 7026 Recovered from Isolation – Confirmed cases to date.

There have been 7327 total Recovered from Isolation to date. This number reflects confirmed positive COVID-19 cases and known presumed positive COVID-19 cases.

Testing

The 3-day average of daily total test taken in Monroe County is currently at 1714 tests per day (PCR). There have been 252,488 total PCR tests received to date in Monroe County.

REMINDER: *There is a discrepancy between the number of tests reported by Monroe County and the number of tests reported by New York State. This is due to the fact that the Monroe County system counts each person tested, while the New York State system counts every test taken. For example, a health care worker who gets tested each week is counted once by Monroe County, and multiple times by New York State.*
