The total number of positive cases to date in Monroe County is 79845.

7-Day Rolling Average Positivity Rate

The 7-day rolling average positivity rate for Monroe County, based on combined NAAT/PCR and Antigen test results (NYS), is 3.9%. The 7-day rolling average positivity rate based on NAAT test results (CDC) is 5.04% (Moderate).
