Total Number of Positive Cases To Date in Monroe County

The total number of positive cases to date in Monroe County is 89177.

7-Day Rolling Average Positivity Rate

The 7-day rolling average positivity rate for Monroe County, based on combined NAAT/PCR and Antigen test results (NYS), is 7.7%. The 7-day rolling average positivity rate based on NAAT test results (CDC) is 9.46% (Moderate).

Case Rate per/100K Over Last 7 days (CDC)

The case rate per/100K over the last 7 days was 371 (High).
