Statement from Monroe County Executive Adam Bello and Commissioner of Public Health

Dr. Michael Mendoza: *Today's significant increase in new cases of COVID-19 is partially attributable to a bump in pre-holiday testing over the past several days, and we are grateful so many of you took this step to protect your loved ones before gathering. Still, while day-to-day fluctuations in cases are less telling than the 7-day rolling average, today's case number is alarming. It is a sober reminder that the pandemic is not done with us yet.
