Monroe County Department of Public Health COVID-19 Weekly Update

Monday, April 11, 2022

Joint Statement from Monroe County Executive Adam Bello and Commissioner of Public Health Dr. Michael Mendoza:

COVID-related hospitalizations are beginning to rise again in the Finger Lakes region. Today, we are reporting a 36% increase in hospitalizations compared to last Monday (166 patients, up from 122 patients on April 4, 2022). This is a concerning trend. While the vast majority of individuals currently infected with COVID are not experiencing severe illness, the BA-2 variant is proving to be dangerous to some. Anyone at higher risk of severe complications from the virus should maintain physical distancing as much as possible and wear a high quality N95 or KN95 mask when in indoor, public settings. Anyone who is eligible for a COVID vaccination or booster shot should get one as soon as possible.

166 individuals are hospitalized for COVID-19 in the Finger Lakes Region (up 44 since Monday, April 4). 21 of these patients are in ICU (up 3 since Monday, April 4).
