Department of Public Health Adding Free Back to School Immunization Clinics for Kids

The Monroe County Department of Public Health is hosting a special series of immunization clinics for children who require a Tdap or meningitis vaccine by the start of the 2023-2024 school year. These vaccines are available for children ages 10- to 19-years-old. There is no cost to families, but appointments are required.
