Monroe County Department of Public Health is investigating potential exposures to COVID-19 at N. Winton Village House Party

The Monroe County Department of Public Health is urging anyone who attended a house party last Saturday evening, April 24, at 221 Carling Road in Rochester's North Winton Village, to immediately self-quarantine and contact the Monroe County COVID-19 Hotline at COVID19@MonroeCounty.gov or (585)753-5555.

These individuals may have been in contact with a college student who has tested positive for COVID-19. Based on the information provided to the MCDPH, the party was attended by students from multiple area colleges and universities.

In general, the Monroe County Department of Public Health does not comment on potential or confirmed cases of COVID-19 concerning specific individuals, businesses or institutions unless doing so is necessary to prevent or lessen a serious and imminent threat to public health.
