

Dental Plan

Dental protection is an important part of a complete benefits program. Monroe County's self-insured dental plan is administered by Health Economics Group Inc. The dental plan encourages preventative dental care by providing full coverage for diagnostic and preventative services at participating dental offices. If charges for a course of treatment are expected to be \$300 or more, a pre-determination of benefits is recommended. Below is a snapshot of the dental plan:

Class III Major Restorative

Dependents' Age Maximum	
Age 19	Age 23 if full-time student
* UCR is the usual, customary and reasonable charge for services in the area it was provided	
** \$1,200 per covered person for Command/Executive Staff
