

Subject: Authorize a Contract with Nardozzi Paving and Construction, LLC for Construction Services for the Hinchey Road Project in the Town of Gates

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Nardozzi Paving and Construction, LLC in the amount of \$5,343,000 for construction services for the Hinchey Road Project in the Town of Gates.

This project involves the construction of paved shoulders, installation of underground stormwater management and storm sewer systems, traffic signal work, minor water main and hydrant relocation work, installation of gutter and curbing in select locations, and the milling and paving of Hinchey Road from Chili Avenue to Pixley Road. The current schedule is to start work in Spring 2023 with an anticipated completion by Fall 2023. The total estimated project cost is \$5,818,000.

The following six (6) bids were received on October 26, 2022:

The bids have been reviewed and Nardozzi Paving and Construction, LLC has been determined to be the lowest responsible bidder pursuant to General Municipal Law §103.

The specific legislative action required is to authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract with Nardozzi Paving and Construction, LLC, 124 N. Genesee Street, Geneva, New York 14456, in the amount of \$5,343,000 for construction services for the Hinchey Road Project in the Town of Gates, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(2) ("replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 1966 and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither Nardozzi Paving and Construction, LLC, nor its sole principal officer, James J. Nardozzi, President, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes.



Subject: Amend the 2023 Capital Budget and Bond Resolution 449 of 2022 to Provide an Increase in Funding and Authorize a Contract with Zoladz Construction Co., Inc. for Construction Services for the Middle Road Project in the Town of Henrietta

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend the 2023 Capital Budget and Bond Resolution 449 of 2022 to provide an increase in funding and authorize a contract with Zoladz Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$2,925,524.66 for construction services for the Middle Road Project in the Town of Henrietta.

This project involves rehabilitation of Middle Road from Erie Station Road to Lehigh Station Road. The work involves the installation of new open and closed drainage systems, reconstruction of the paved shoulders, milling and resurfacing of the asphalt along with new pavement markings. There are currently insufficient funds available for the project due to recent increases in the cost of construction such as the price of asphalt, as well as other material and labor along with the need to reconstruct a wider section of roadway than originally anticipated. The current schedule is to start work in Spring 2023 with an anticipated completion by Fall 2023. The total estimated project cost is now \$4,010,000.

The bids have been reviewed and Zoladz Construction Co., Inc. has been determined to be the lowest responsible bidder pursuant to General Municipal Law §103.

The specific legislative actions required are:

1. Amend the 2023 Capital Budget to increase the project authorization by \$430,000 for the Middle Road Project from \$3,580,000 to \$4,010,000, making the total project authorization \$4,010,000.

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- 2. Amend Bond Resolution 449 of 2022 to increase financing for the Middle Road Project, capital fund 1995, from \$3,580,000 to \$4,010,000, for a total authorization of \$4,010,000.
- 3. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract with Zoladz Construction Co., Inc., 13600 Railroad Street, Alden, New York 14004, in the amount of \$2,925,524.66, for construction services for the Middle Road Project in the Town of Henrietta, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(2) ("replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, will be included in capital fund 1995 once the additional financing authorization requested herein is approved and any capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.
