Amend the 2023 Capital Budget and Bond Resolution 45 of 2021 to Provide an Increase in Funding for

Construction Services for the Lake Road II Project in the Town of Webster

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body amend the 2023 Capital Budget and Bond Resolution 45 of 2021 to provide an increase in funding in the amount of \$350,000 for the Lake Road II Project in the Town of Webster.

This project involves rehabilitation/widening of Lake Road from Bay Road to Pellett Road. The work involves pavement rehabilitation and shoulder widening, full depth pavement reconstruction at some locations to improve sight distance, curb, gutters, water main improvements, and closed drainage replacement. There are currently insufficient funds available for the project due to increased costs since it was initially programmed in the Capital Improvement Program. The increase is due to the large escalation in the costs of fuel and asphalt during this two year project. Costs for construction inspection were also higher than originally anticipated.

#### The specific legislative actions required are:

- 1. Amend the 2023 Capital Budget to increase funding for the Lake Road II Project in the Town of Webster, in the amount of \$350,000 from \$10,500,000 to \$10,850,000, for a total project authorization of \$10,850,000.
- 2. Amend Bond Resolution 45 of 2021 to increase financing for the Lake Road II Project in the Town of Webster, capital fund 1841, in the amount of \$350,000 from \$10,500,000 to \$10,850,000, for a total project authorization of \$10,850,000.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(2) ("replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, will be included in capital fund 1841 once the additional financing authorization herein is approved and in any other capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

I recommend that this matter be referred to the appropriate committee(s) for favorable action by Your Honorable Body.

Authorize a Contract with Keeler Construction Co., Inc. for Construction Services and Authorize an Intermunicipal Agreement with the Town of Pittsford in Conjunction with the Stone Road Culverts Project in the Town of Pittsford

### Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body authorize a contract with Keeler Construction Co., Inc. in the amount of \$1,133,701.65 for construction services and authorize an intermunicipal agreement with the Town of Pittsford in conjunction with the Stone Road Culverts project in the Town of Pittsford.

This project involves replacement of two box culverts on Stone Road: the first culvert is located approximately 900 feet west of Clover Street and the second is located approximately 1600 feet east of Clover Street. The work involves removal of the existing culverts and replacements with new precast concrete box culverts. Installation of new asphalt pavement, bridge railing, signs, and pavement markings will also be completed at each culvert location. In addition, during the design for the Stone Road Culverts project, the Town of Pittsford requested having the culverts extended 10' to the south in order to accommodate a future mixed-use Town Trail, and reimbursing the County for the appropriate costs relating to this work. The current schedule is to start work in spring 2023 with an anticipated completion by fall 2023.

The following four (4) bids were received on December 8, 2022:

The bids have been reviewed and Keeler Construction Co., Inc. has been determined to be the lowest responsible bidder pursuant to General Municipal Law §103.

### The specific legislative actions required are:

1. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract with Keeler Construction Co., Inc., 13519 W. Lee Road, Albion, New York 14411, in the amount of \$1,133,701.65 for construction services for the Stone Road Culverts Project in the Town of Pittsford, and any amendments necessary to complete the project within the total capital fund(s) appropriation.

2. Authorize the County Executive, or his designee, to execute a contract, and any amendments thereto, with the Town of Pittsford for reimbursement to Monroe County of appropriate design and construction costs relating to the culvert extensions for a future mixed-use trail in conjunction with the Stone Road Culverts project, in the estimated amount of \$160,000, with the final amount to be determined upon project completion.

This action is a Type II Action pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 617.5(c)(2) ("replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site") and is not subject to further review under the State Environmental Quality Review Act.

Funding for this contract, consistent with authorized uses, is included in capital fund 2066 and any other capital fund(s) created for the same intended purpose. No additional net County support is required in the current Monroe County budget.

The records in the office of the Monroe County Treasury have indicated that neither Keeler Construction Co., Inc., nor any of its principal officers, owe any delinquent Monroe County property taxes. The principal officers of the firm are:
