Subject: Mortgage Tax Distribution

Honorable Legislators:

I recommend that Your Honorable Body approve the Mortgage Tax Distribution for the period of October 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013.

MORTGAGE TAX DISTRIBUTION

WHEREAS, in compliance with Section 261 of the Tax Law, the County Clerk and the Director of Finance have filed with the Clerk of the Legislature and the New York State Tax Commission a joint report (File No. 00), showing the total amount of Mortgage Tax allocated to the various tax districts in Monroe County to be \$7,015,234.08, for the period October 1, 2012 through March 31, 2013
