

Common Ground Health brings together leaders from across our nine-county region to collaborate on strategies for improving health & confronting health challenges.




SMH/GOLISANO CHILDREN'S HEALTH HOME PROGRAM

Children's Health Home Care Management services: linkage to medical/behavioral health providers and communitybased supports and services. Our Care Management Agency is a program through the Department of Pediatrics in the Golisano Children's Hospital. We are contracted with the Children's Health Home of Upstate NY and work within DOH and hospital compliance policies. Anyone can make a referral including parents, teachers, providers and community workers. We are an elective program but eligibility criteria must be met and engagement from member and family is required to remain enrolled. Members generally utilize our services for an average of 12-18 months.
