## **MONROE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ADAM BELLO ANNOUNCES VACCINATION SITES TO BE HELD AT RCSD SCHOOLS**

(Rochester, NY) — Monroe County Executive Adam Bello today announced a series of COVID-19 vaccination clinics scheduled next week at various Rochester City Schools. The clinics will have first, second, and booster doses of the Pfizer, Moderna, and Johnson & Johnson COVID-19 vaccine.

Appointments are encouraged, but walk-ins are also welcome. Appointments are available via [www.monroecounty.gov](http://www.monroecounty.gov). All clinics run from 4-7 p.m. and are in addition to the county's regularly scheduled COVID-19 vaccination sites.
