ANNOUNCES COUNTY GOLF COURSES TO OPEN
TUESDAY, APRIL 21 FOR 2026 SEASON**

ROCHESTER, NY — County Executive Adam Bello today announced the return of golf at Monroe County Parks' three public golf courses. Beginning Tuesday, April 21, the golf courses at Durand Eastman, Genesee Valley and Churchville will open for the 2026 season.

"Monroe County's three affordable and accessible public golf courses add to the tremendous quality of life residents here enjoy throughout warmer months," **said County Executive Bello**. "I encourage everyone, no matter your skill level, to take advantage of the warm weather ahead and hit the links."

Genesee Valley Golf Course offers two exceptionally-maintained 18-hole golf courses, an all-grass driving range, and the Calvin Peete Pitch & Putt practice area. Churchville features 27 holes of championship golf, a large practice putting and chipping green, and an all-grass driving range. Durand Eastman is a Robert Trent Jones, Sr.-designed 18-hole championship golf course in a beautiful park setting. In addition to rounds of golf, residents can take part in lessons, tournaments, and leagues at all three Monroe County golf courses.

Free permits for discounted greens fees throughout the season are available for seniors age 62 and over, active military, veterans, youth 17 and under, and golfers with a physician-certified disability. Qualifying residents can apply for a free permit at any pro shop at each of the three county courses.

Due to wet course conditions, driving ranges are currently closed. They will open for the 2026 golf season when conditions permit.
