MONROE COUNTY EXECUTIVE ADAM BELLO ANNOUNCES NEW ALLEGIANT AIR NON-STOP ROUTE FROM THE FREDERICK DOUGLASS GREATER ROCHESTER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TO SARASOTA, FLORIDA

Flights begin in February, 2026

ROCHESTER, NY — Monroe County Executive Adam Bello today announced that the Frederick Douglass Greater Rochester International Airport (ROC) is adding another non-stop route to Southwest Florida. Starting February 13, 2026, Allegiant Air will begin non-stop service twiceweekly between ROC and the Sarasota Bradenton International Airport (SRQ).

"Whether it's a family beach day on Siesta Key or an eco-tour of the mangrove tunnel, Sarasota is now a low-cost non-stop flight from home," said County Executive Bello. "Allegiant Air's new non-stop service from Rochester to Sarasota expands access to Florida's Gulf Coast for our residents for less than the cost of a dinner and movie. Thank you to Allegiant for adding to their investment at our airport and providing more options for both business and leisure travelers."

"We are excited to continue our growth trajectory with our new route from Rochester, New York to Sarasota/Bradenton, Florida," said Drew Wells, Allegiant's chief commercial officer. "As a leisure focused airline, our unique business model allows us to quickly respond to consumer demand and connect underserved markets to top vacation destinations."

Allegiant's Rochester/Sarasota route will run Fridays and Mondays starting February 13, 2026. The seasonal route will continue through May 2026, with one-way fares as low as \$59.
